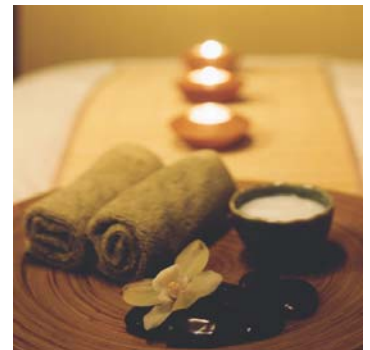

**Wolfe Island Wind Turbine Tour
Saturday, June 26, 2010 (9:30 a.m. - 1:30 p.m.)**



The winds of Kingston are a boon to the sailors and wind surfers who come from around the world to enjoy the exhilaration of sustained strong winds off Lake Ontario. These same winds are ushering in a new era of renewable energy that is, for the most part, environmentally benign and relatively easy to harness. Kingston is ideally situated at the eastern end of Lake Ontario, whose flat expanse presents no obstacles to a free flow of air along its length. The winds are consistent and generally strong. In addition, Wolfe Island off the Kingston shoreline helps funnel these winds down the St. Lawrence River.

So come on out and learn about these monster turbines, as you take the ferry across to Wolfe Island aboard a bus where a representative from Canadian Hydro Developers Inc. will educate you on Kingston's wind farms covering the economic, social, and environmental impact of the wind plant, the logistics of construction, the anatomy of a turbine etc. You'll also get a chance to visit the Operation and Maintenance building for a view of the spare blades and submarine cables. Lunch on your own on Wolfe Island or back in Kingston.
